

I would like to introduce myself and inform you of the new role I will have at Ellsworth Public School.



Most of you probably know who I am as I am a lifelong resident of Ellsworth. After graduating from EHS I went to the University of South Dakota and received my degree in Criminal Justice. After graduation I worked in many capacities at Southwestern Youth Services in Magnolia working with male juvenile's in a correctional setting for 17 years. I then went to work at the family plumbing and heating business in Ellsworth for the past 9 years but decided I was ready to find a career where I could work with kids again. So, I am the new At-Risk Coordinator for Ellsworth Public School. I will be working with students, families, and other agencies to prevent truancy, drop outs, at-risk behaviors, criminal activities, tardiness, and other areas that are deemed necessary to help students be successful. When school personnel, agencies, parents or students make referrals, we will work collaboratively to assist the student as a team and provide consistent guidance to resolve problems which may be preventing school success. The At-Risk Coordinator is an important link between the school and community agencies, which provide services necessary to resolve problems that can inhibit a student's school success. All students attending school at Ellsworth are eligible for At-Risk services.

Indoor Air Quality Parent Notification

August 2022

Dear Parent or Guardian:

Re: Indoor Air Quality (Ellsworth Public School)

LS.D. #514 now has in place a program to monitor and improve indoor air quality at our school. The Ellsworth School District considers no objective more important than providing its employees, students, and visitors a healthy, safe environment. Because we believe that indoor air quality is essential to this objective we are sending this notification to inform parents, students and staff of our program to monitor and improve indoor air quality.

As part of the program implementation, an Indoor Air Quality Coordinator has been appointed. An annual walk-through will be performed by the Coordinator to evaluate school facilities for obvious water intrusion, ventilation failures, structural problems, overall cleanliness, and the status of the O & M program.

In that we have adopted the EPA's <u>Tools for Schools</u>, the guidelines contained therein will be used to evaluate all classrooms, ventilation systems, and building maintenance issues.

The District's response to parental concerns will be timely and direct. Parent's questions are always welcome. If a concern would arise we ask the parent to contact John Willey, Indoor Air Quality Coordinator. The Coordinator will be able to assist in evaluating the child's home or other out of school situation. Additional information is available to parents about school facility construction; maintenance, housekeeping practices, chemicals used, mold and HVAC related information, and other activities that may contribute to a child's symptoms.

ISD #514 accepts the responsibility of monitoring indoor air quality and will/has conducted a survey of the mechanical ventilation rate of each occupied space in the District.

Ellsworth Public School is proud to be taking a leadership role in providing a safe, comfortable, and productive environment for our students and staff so that we achieve our core mission-educating students. Our school will continue to follow EPA guidance to improve our indoor air quality by preventing as many problems as possible.

Annual Asbestos Notification

2022-2023 School Year

As a result of recent federal legislation (Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act – AHERA), each primary and secondary school in the nation is required to complete a stringent new inspection for asbestos and to develop a plan of management for all asbestos-containing building materials. ISD #514 has a goal to be in full compliance with this law and is following the spirit, as well as, the letter of the law. As a matter of policy, ISD #514 shall continue to maintain a safe and healthy environment for our community's youth and employees.

In keeping with this legislation, all buildings (including portables and support buildings) owned or leased by the school district were inspected by EPA accredited inspectors and an independent laboratory analyzed samples. Based on the inspection, the district prepared and the state approved a comprehensive management plan for handling the asbestos located within its buildings safely and responsibly.

Furthermore, ISD #514 has completed its AHERA 3-year re-inspection requirements every three years. The districts buildings, where asbestos-containing materials were found, are under repair, removal and Operations and Maintenance.

This past year, ISD #514 conducted the following with respect to its asbestos containing building materials:

Federal law requires a periodic walk-through (called "surveillance") every six months of each area containing asbestos. Also the law requires for all buildings to be re-inspected every three years after a management plan is in effect. This will be accomplished under contract by Advanced Health, Safety and Security.

Short-term workers (outside contractors) must be provided information regarding the location of asbestos in which they may come into contact. All short-term workers shall contact the lead maintenance person before commencing work to be given this information.

ISD #514 has a list of the location(s), type(s) of asbestos-containing materials found in that school building and a description and timetable for their proper management. A copy of the Asbestos Management Plan is available for review in the school office. Copies are available at 25 cents per page. Questions related to the plan should be directed to the district office, which will establish contact with our Account Manager under contract with Advanced Health, Safety and Security.
