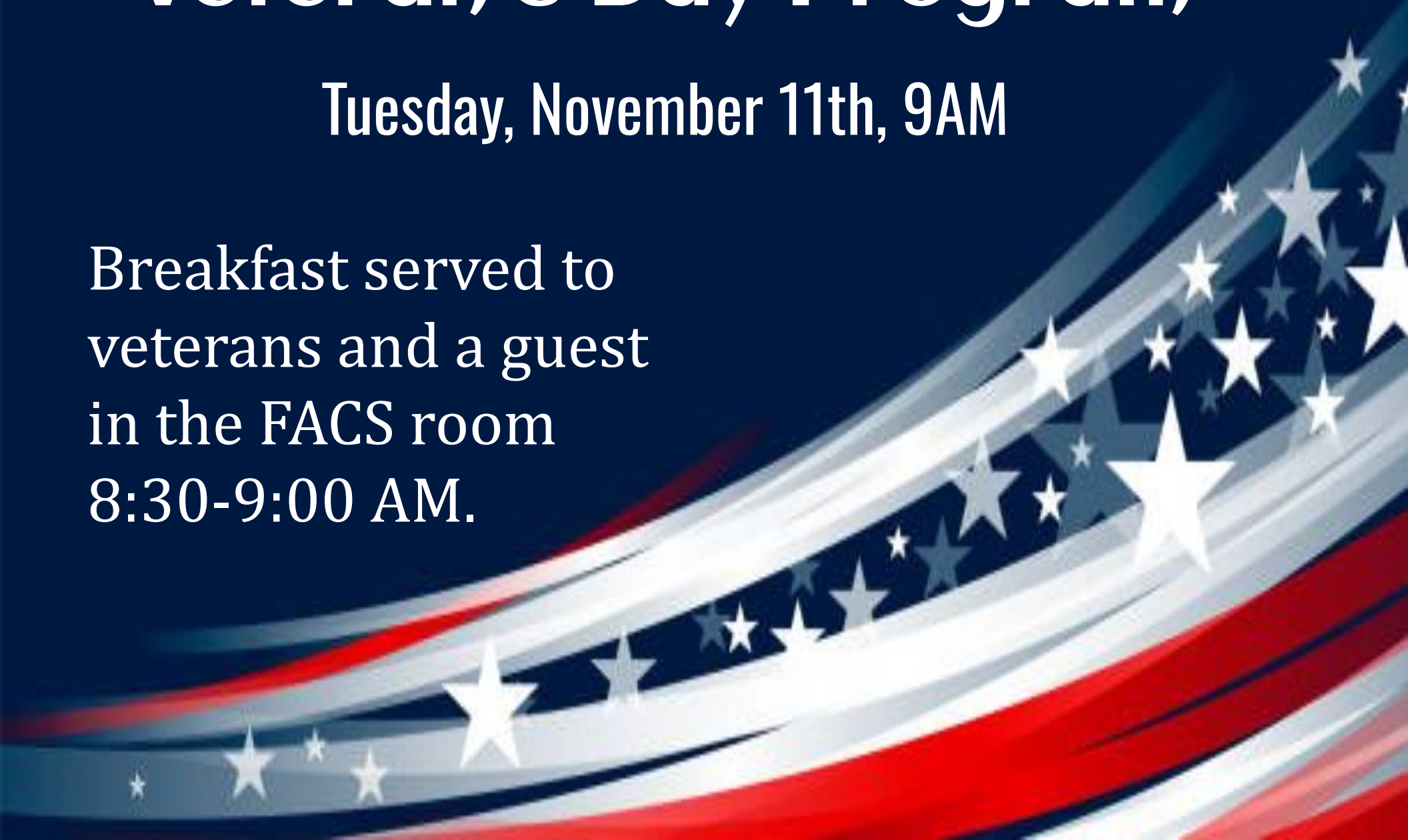

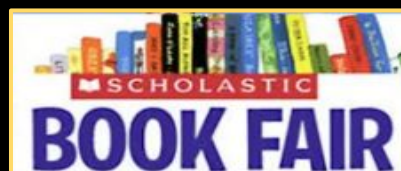

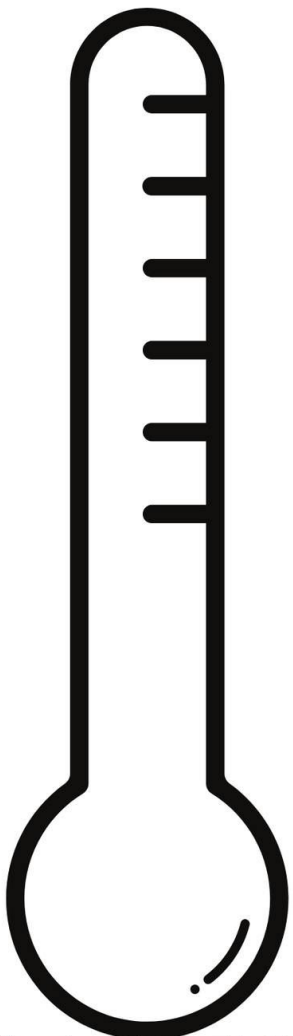

ELLSWORTH ELEMENTARY

OUTDOOR CLOTHING GUIDELINES

- Morning Recess (JP - 2nd): Inside when snow gear becomes required
- Lunch Recess (PK - 5th): Inside if raining or "**FEELS LIKE**" temperature is below 0 degrees
- Dress for the weather - once outside, you stay outside.



60+	• Short Sleeves • Boots (if muddy)
50-60	• Long sleeves / light jacket • Boots (if muddy)
40-50	• Winter Coat or Light Jacket • Boots (if muddy)
"Feels Like" 30-40	• Winter Coat • Hat • Mittens • Boots (if muddy) • Snowpants (optional)
"Feels Like" 20 to 30	• Snowpants (optional without snow) • Winter Coat • Hat • Mittens • Boots
"Feels Like" 0 to 20	• Snowpants • Winter Coat • Hat • Mittens • Boots
"Feels Like" Below Zero	• Inside
